Overview 2022-2023 (Fall 2023)

LSC helps students foster connections with peers, course material, LSC instructors, and with themselves as learners.

LSC is widely-used: in 2022-23 there were ~20,000 student-visits to LSC office hours, tutoring, workshops, consultations and support courses.



LSC supports students across all undergraduate colleges in more than **50 different Cornell classes**.

LSC has a very strong on-line presence. From July 2022-June 2023,

- There were over 300,000 (more than a quarter-million!) views of our You-Tube videos.
- 543 students enrolled in study skills modules on Canvas, they made over 8,000 page views.
- lsc.cornell.edu had 438,180 users and 718,437 pageviews

The LSC Scholarship funded 277 students to help them meet timely graduation goals taking Summer and Winter Session courses.

2926 requests came from students looking for study partners in 598 unique courses. LSC made 1651 matches leading to 717 study groups.



LSC's growing support for neurodiverse students includes consultations, workshops, and community-building opportunities through Neurodiversity@Cornell, including over 250 participants in a variety of events during Neurodiversity Celebration Week.
